

Darren Osborne Terrorism Verdict

The Muslim Welfare House today welcomed the verdict passed on Darren Osborne; as he was rightly convicted of terrorism offences and sentenced to life in prison. Osborne cruelly and remorselessly drove his van into a group of worshippers from Muslim Welfare House, claiming the life of Makram Ali, as he returned home from prayers as well as angering many more in Finsbury Park, our prayers and hearts are with the victims and their families.

Toufik Kacimi, CEO of Welfare House said: “After being subject to such a callous attack, the congregation at Muslim Welfare House can take some consolation in the verdict reached today.”

Mr Kacimi added: “We would like to especially thank the police and the emergency services again for their efforts, as well as the Crown Prosecution Service in ensuring justice was served. We are also pleased that the courts have rightly ruled that the attack was indeed terrorist in nature. The terror threat from far-right groups is real, and we hope that as a country we can rise to meet that threat.”
